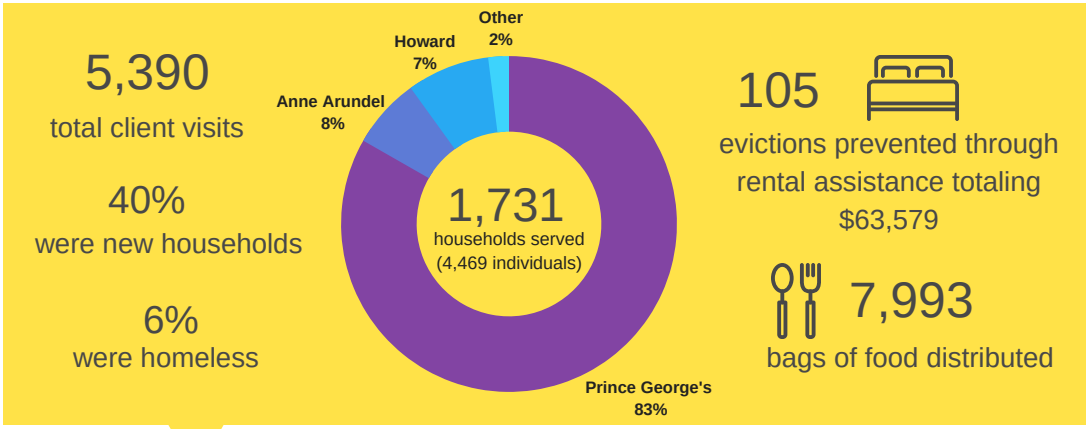


FY2018 ANNUAL REPORT

Our mission is to enable homeless and low-income people in Laurel, MD who are in crisis to achieve stability and long-term self-sufficiency.



25 chronically homeless and disabled families/ individuals were safely housed through LARS' Permanent Supportive Housing Program. All current households (22) have obtained medical insurance and 14 clients increased their annual income.

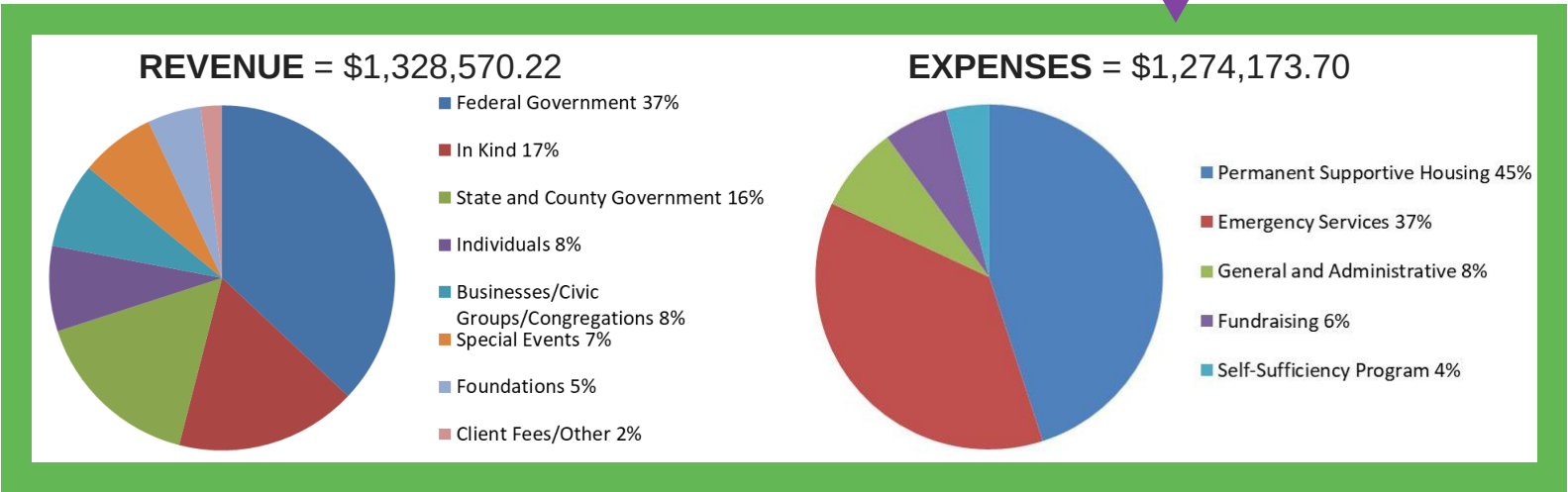
7 households enrolled in one-on-one mentoring through LARS' Self-Sufficiency Program.

50 adults and children received vouchers for free eye exams and eyeglasses

107 households received vouchers for free clothing and furniture

478 children had their holiday wish lists fulfilled by generous donors to LARS' Holiday Program

196 households met with an outreach worker from the Prince George's County Department of Social Services for help obtaining public benefits
